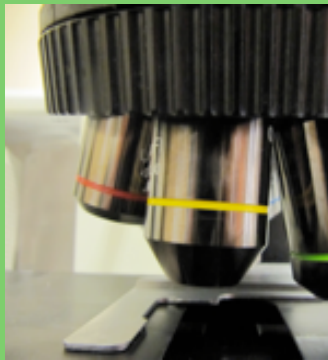
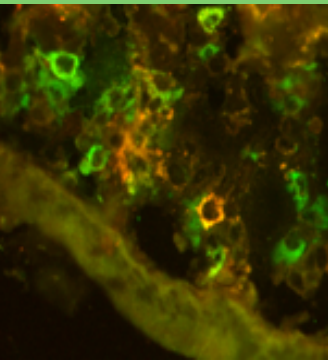

on behalf of the COST-ENTIRE (European Network for Translational Immunology Research and Education) framework and local organizers we would like to invite you to participate on the **School for Translational Immunology (STI) to be held in April 23 - 26, 2014 in Tallinn, Estonia**. This school is organized by COST-ENTIRE in collaboration with University of Tartu and Estonian Society for Immunology and Allergology and has a special aim to bring together and train graduate students, doctoral fellows and scientists of immunology field from different countries around the Europe. The topic of the school will focus on different aspects of translational immunology with clinical relevance. Steering committee will review all applications by March 10, 2014 and confirmed list of trainees will be published on the STI website. All applicants will also receive feedback in writing via e-mail.

Registration fees:

<u>Regular fee for international trainees</u>	<u>270 €</u>
Regular fee includes participation of all scientific sessions, poster session with refreshments and snacks, all meals during 3 days, accommodation in twin room (1 place in twin room).	
<u>Special accommodation fee for international trainees</u>	<u>360 €</u>
Special accommodation fee includes participation of all scientific sessions, poster session with refreshments and snacks, all meals during 3 days, accommodation in single room.	
<u>Attending fee for local trainees</u>	<u>150 €</u>
Attending fee includes participation of all scientific sessions, poster session with refreshments and snacks, all meals during 3 days. In case of a need for accommodation, regular fee 270 € applies.	
<u>Single day admission for local trainees (April 24 or 25)</u>	<u>100 €</u>
Single day admission includes participation of the scientific sessions during 1 selected day, poster session with refreshments and snacks.
